

SACRED HEART SCHOOL DRESS CODE

Sacred Heart School will maintain a dress code policy for the following reasons:

- To encourage a sense of school unity, identity, and pride.
- To allow for minimal cost to parents.
- To encourage a positive self-image, eliminate comparison and competition, and enhance performance.
- To help students acquire an appropriate sense of dress, along with the guidance of the parents.
- **All clothes must be modest and reflective of the values expected at Sacred Heart Catholic School.**

- “Uniform style” bottoms may be purchased through major retail stores under their school uniform line and should be similar to the uniform styles from the following lines: Target, JCPenney, Old Navy, Gap, Wal-Mart, Children’s Place, Land’s End, Sear’s, Kohl’s, and Macy’s.
 - All students are expected to wear clothing that is clean, in good repair (no holes or fraying), and properly fits. No low-cut, sagging, or low-riding pants, jeans, shorts, or skorts are allowed.
 - All students are expected to be well groomed, neat, clean, and presentable while at school.
 - No flip-flops (polyurethane plastic/unsecured/un-bonded Y-strap or non Y-strap type).
 - Parents must bring appropriate dress attire for students if he/she is not dressed per the uniform policy. The administration makes all final determinations.

Free Dress Days

- At the discretion of the Principal. Remind notifications will be sent. Will be allowed for school pictures.
- Students are expected to exercise good judgement and modesty when choosing free dress items. Anything questionable modesty or content may be referred back to parents by administration.
- **Leggings are not considered pants and may only be worn under dresses, skirts, or skorts.**
- Staff will monitor the dress code policy.
- Concert attire: dresses/skirts must be 1 inch above knees or longer. No spaghetti straps or sleeveless tops are allowed unless covered by jacket, cardigan, or shawl.
- Off-campus school functional attire will be at the discretion of the administration and notification will be sent.

Shirts: long-sleeve polo, short-sleeve polo, long-sleeved t-shirt, or short-sleeved t-shirt with Sacred Heart School logo. Shorts and capris: may be worn during August-October and April-May. • Shorts length: 1 inch above knees or longer.	Color style: KHAKI • Khaki: tan color family • Uniform style
Skirt / Jumper: • Length: 1 inch above knees or longer. • Khaki or Black shorts <u>MUST</u> be worn underneath skirt or jumper if not wearing leggings. • Solid BLACK full ankle-length tights/leggings must be worn underneath November-March.
